



Visiting Yachtsmen

The Savannah Yacht Club is a private club and is not open to the public. However, the General Manager has the discretion to issue guest cards to visiting yachtsmen based on a prior letter of introduction from their home club stating that they are a member in good standing and that their home club will accept all charges incurred during their stay. The letter must be dated within 30 days of arrival and may be faxed to 912.897.0876 or emailed to sam@savannahyachtclub.org for consideration. All guests who use the Dock facilities must pay the charges established by the SYC Executive Committee for such use.

LOCATION

The Savannah Yacht Club is located on the banks of The Wilmington River at Whitemarsh Island.

Located right on the Intra-Coastal Waterway, the club is one mile south of mile marker 585 and near marker # 38 in the Wilmington River.

Visiting yachtsmen may see our tower with the green cupola on our Wilmington River Docks well in advance of arrival.

When you have the club in sight, contact our dock staff on VHF radio channel 16. They will switch you over to our working channel 72 and talk you into your docking location.

The club is convenient to the Savannah Historic District via a 15 minute cab ride and to Wilmington Island (5 minutes away), as well as the Town of Thunderbolt (8 minutes away).

DINING IN THE CLUBHOUSE

Once a guest card is arranged, reservations must be made prior to dining in our Clubhouse. This may be arranged through the dock staff upon arrival or by calling in advance at (912) 644-4100. Collared shirts must be worn inside the club and blue jeans are not permitted. The Savannah Yacht Club is a smoke-free facility.

FUEL/PUMP-OUT DOCK

Diesel, gasoline, and waste pump-out are available year-round. Owners are required to pump their own fuel and waste. The dock staff will pass hoses aboard. Boats at the fuel dock must be attended at all times. Ice is available at the Dock Office. All charges will be billed back to the visitor's host club.
